Welcome to the Livestock Information Service (LIS) Abattoir journey. This user guide will provide detailed steps on how abattoirs can check the veterinary attestation record status of holdings.

## Livestock Information Service

The Livestock Information Service for reporting sheep, goat and deer movements.

### Welcome to the Livestock Information Service

The Livestock Information Service (LIS) provides a single sign-on platform for livestock keepers and those in the supply chain to report livestock movements in England. It is currently just for sheep, goat and deer, but cattle and pig movement services will soon follow, to create a single, modern, digital movement service for all species.

### Livestock Reporting

The Livestock Information Service can currently be used for reporting sheep, goat and deer movements in England. There is also an option to maintain an online Holding Register by recording other livestock events such as tagging. A Veterinary Attestation can now be recorded by a registered Veterinary Surgeon and can be viewed by an abattoir.

Using the online service to report your livestock movements makes a real difference for traceability - digital notifications are faster and more accurate.

### Create account or Sign in

To create an account, you will need a County Parish Holding (CPH) number and be registered as a keeper.

### Are you a Veterinarian looking to record a visit for a holding?

You will be required to sign in via the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS) to access the Livestock Information Service and record a visit for a holding.

- Select the 'Create account/sign in' button.

- If you forget your login details, use the 'Forgot username' or 'Forgot password' links to reset it.

### 3. Dashboard:

- Once logged in, you will be shown the dashboard screen.
- From the dashboard, select your holding and choose 'Sheep' under 'Species'.

## 5. Veterinary Attestations – ways to check vet attestation status:

vet attestation status can be checked by:

- Tag number manually
- Multiple tag numbers via CSV upload
- By holding number (CPH)

#### Check a tag number manually

To check the attestation status of one or more tags, click the button below

## 6. Checking a Tag Number Manually:

- Select the 'click here' hyperlink to manually check tag numbers.

### Check a tag number manually

#### Manual tag entry

Enter the individual tag numbers manually or copy and paste.

- Enter tag numbers (up to 200) manually or via copy and paste.
- A question mark tooltip explains how tag numbers can be copied.
- Click the 'Add' button and review the table.

## 8. Checking Multiple Tag Numbers via CSV Upload:

- Select the 'click here' hyperlink to upload a CSV file.

### Check multiple tag numbers

#### Upload a file

If you have a list of tag numbers in a spreadsheet you can save it as a CSV and browse your device to upload the file here.

**Note:** the Flock number and individual number must be in the same cell on the spreadsheet, and the column should not have a heading.

Upload a CSV file with a maximum of 200 tag numbers

- Information will be provided on the valid tag formats.
- Click ‘Browse’ to select a CSV file from your device. CSV files should not exceed 200 tags.
- Click ‘Upload’ to upload your CSV file.

- Click 'Remove all invalid' to remove all invalid tags from the table.
- Click 'Clear all' to remove all tags from the table.
- The 'Search' button will be enabled when there are no invalid tags in the table.
- Click 'Search' to proceed to the results page.

## 9. Checking by Holding Number:

## Check by holding number

- For guidance on CPH format select the 'Question mark' tooltip.
- Enter the County Parish Holding (CPH) for the holding you want to check.
- Click the 'Search' button to validate the CPH and view the results.
- If the CPH is invalid or has no digital records, you will be shown a 'No data found' message. You will need a CPH with digital records to see results.
